She was a lead in the 2015 musical Pippin, and she was very active in the school's choir and band. Every summer Emily went with her church youth group on a mission trip. She also mentored younger peers by being a breakout group leader for her youth group.

Emily had a loveable personality and became friends with everyone she met. She was a devoted friend and family member who was always there. Emily will be forever missed but never forgotten.

The memorial walk/run is a fundraiser for a scholarship that will be awarded to two students this year and each year as funds continue. The criteria for the scholarship include maintaining a 3.5 GPA while managing a challenging course load. They must be well-rounded students involved in school athletics, clubs, and activities, as well as being involved in church and the community.
