



## Rules for May Day Sign-ups And Practices

1. Sophomore girls will be allowed to sign up for participation in the Sophomore Arch. Girls must return the bottom portion of this page signed by a parent or guardian at the time they sign up.
2. Junior girls will be allowed to sign up for participation in the Maypole Dance if they have secured a junior boy escort to sign up at the same time (the boy does not have to come and sign up). Girls must return the bottom portion of this page signed by a parent or guardian at the time they sign up.
3. If there is any need to limit numbers, cutting will be done from the bottom of the list.
4. Only the girl herself will be allowed to sign up, with the following exception: if a girl is sick or injured or for some other reason unable to be at school to sign up for herself, a member of her immediate family (parent, brother, etc.) may come to sign her up. The family member must wait in line and sign up in order. A friend may not substitute for a family member. If a girl is unable to be here to sign up, her name will be at the bottom of the list.
5. Any girl who is cut from the list of active participants for any reason will become an alternate. If an active participant is unable to participate for any reason, an alternate will replace her. In the case of sudden illness or injury, a person may still be allowed to take part in some manner determined by Mrs. Kleinschmidt.
6. Attendance is **required** at all practices, both those on the list and any others that are announced. **No absence** is allowed from practice, although a student who is ill and absent from school will be allowed one miss. Due to the practice schedule and the time required to learn the Sophomore Arch walk-in and Maypole Dance, an absence for any other reason or two absences due to any reason may result in a student not being allowed to participate. Being tardy to practice may count as an absence.
7. **Apparel—Juniors:** Dresses are to be floor length and pastel or pastel prints. Dresses must be appropriate for a high-school program and in good taste. Any questions, see Mrs. Kleinschmidt. Junior escorts are to wear a suit or sport coat and nice slacks. Junior girls will carry tulips and escorts will wear a boutonniere. Cost will be approx. \$15 and will be announced and paid for at practice.  
**Sophomores:** Dresses need to be street-length (at or below the knee) and pastel or pastel prints. No strapless or off-the-shoulder dresses. Dresses must be appropriate for a high school program. White gloves must be worn. Girls will wear wrist corsages. Cost will be approximately \$10 and will be announced and paid for at practice.
